GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSEMBLING

U. S. S. NAUTILUS NO. C15

This kit contains all parts for making an authentic scale model 1/32-inch to 1 foot. Compare all parts with those shown in full size on drawing before starting to assemble.

Follow the instructions carefully and you will be much more pleased with your finished model.

GLUE

Mix only a small quantity of glue at a time. Be careful to use just the right amount of water, adding a little at a time and mixing until the glue is creamy. No clamps needed.

SANDING

Glue the coarse sandpaper to one end of the \\(\frac{1}{8}"x1"x5" \) piece of wood so that it can be used as a file. Before assembling the pieces, sand the surface which will be exposed after gluing and give particular attention to the end grain on each piece.


Use the coarse sandpaper first where much sanding is required and always finish with the fine sandpaper for a good smooth model.

FINISH

Many model makers prefer to finish their models in a natural wood finish using either shellac or clear varnish. If you wish to paint your model in the regular Nautilus color, finish it in battleship gray. For a good finish apply two coats of paint. Sand lightly with worn sandpaper between first and second coat.

To make your model more realistic you may cut out these numbers and the name of the ship and paste them in place on each side (See photograph on carton).
